

Save Our Space – A community centre for Central Cambridge

An opportunity for Cambridge businesses to invest in the local community



The Petersfield community have now pledged over £500,000 in shares to buy the Sturton Street chapel and hall and run it as an inclusive, thriving community centre.

The site will go onto the open market at the beginning of March and the Save our Space campaign Group, run by Petersfield Area Community Trust (PACT), will need to be able to place a competitive bid to acquire the site.

The centre will become home to a pre-school nursery, a children's dance school, clubs and classes. It will host community events and exhibitions throughout the year and become a cultural community hub in this highly populated area of the city. Through the more commercial elements of the programme, such as the nursery and hiring of space, it will become a sustainable business. The centre will be run by the Sturton Society Limited, with close links to the Petersfield Area Community Trust. Visit www.sturton.org for more details.
